- Review 2nd Qtr Financials Question regarding petty cash compared year to year from Jay. Comcast revenue declining for first time about 2-3%/year. However now we have new State revenue. The VAN funds will be distributed in a weighted formula, as bigger stations are also seeing a drop. It has been a big help at MMCTV in terms of extra hours of part-time staff and field producers.
